

Jungletour 2011

For the refugees' rights

For the second year, the bike Jungletour will link different places where refugees have to stay, and they themselves call "jungle". Its aim is to strengthen the relations between the associations involved with them, to raise the awareness of the population and to challenge policy makers on the living conditions of refugees and respect for their rights.

The 2011 Jungletour will travel the North - Pas-de-Calais and Belgium from July 2 to 14, from Bailleul and Lille to Brussels, via Calais and Ostend.

As migration policies became more restrictive borders between Europe (Schengen) and the United Kingdom (which is not part of the Schengen area) were closed. Hundreds of refugees were stranded. Rejected by the United Kingdom and undesirable on this side of the Channel and North Sea, they live in ditches, woods and dunes, or in abandoned buildings, parks, close ports, from Roscoff in Brittany to Zeebrugge in Belgium, via Cherbourg, Calais and Dunkirk, near the motorway services where they try to board the trucks going to England, or in major cities inland.

But this is only a step in the migrants' itinerary across Europe. Countries joining the EU are doing everything to turn away refugees or prevent them from remaining, and if needed some do not respect the right of asylum (in Greece and Cyprus, less than 1% asylum applications are accepted). And the other countries refuse to consider their request for asylum when their fingerprints were taken in a first country and integrated into the European EURODAC file. European Dublin II Regulation provides that a person can seek asylum in only one country of the European Union, and how to determine this country - most often it is the country of entry into the European Union, with the taking of fingerprints as proof.
